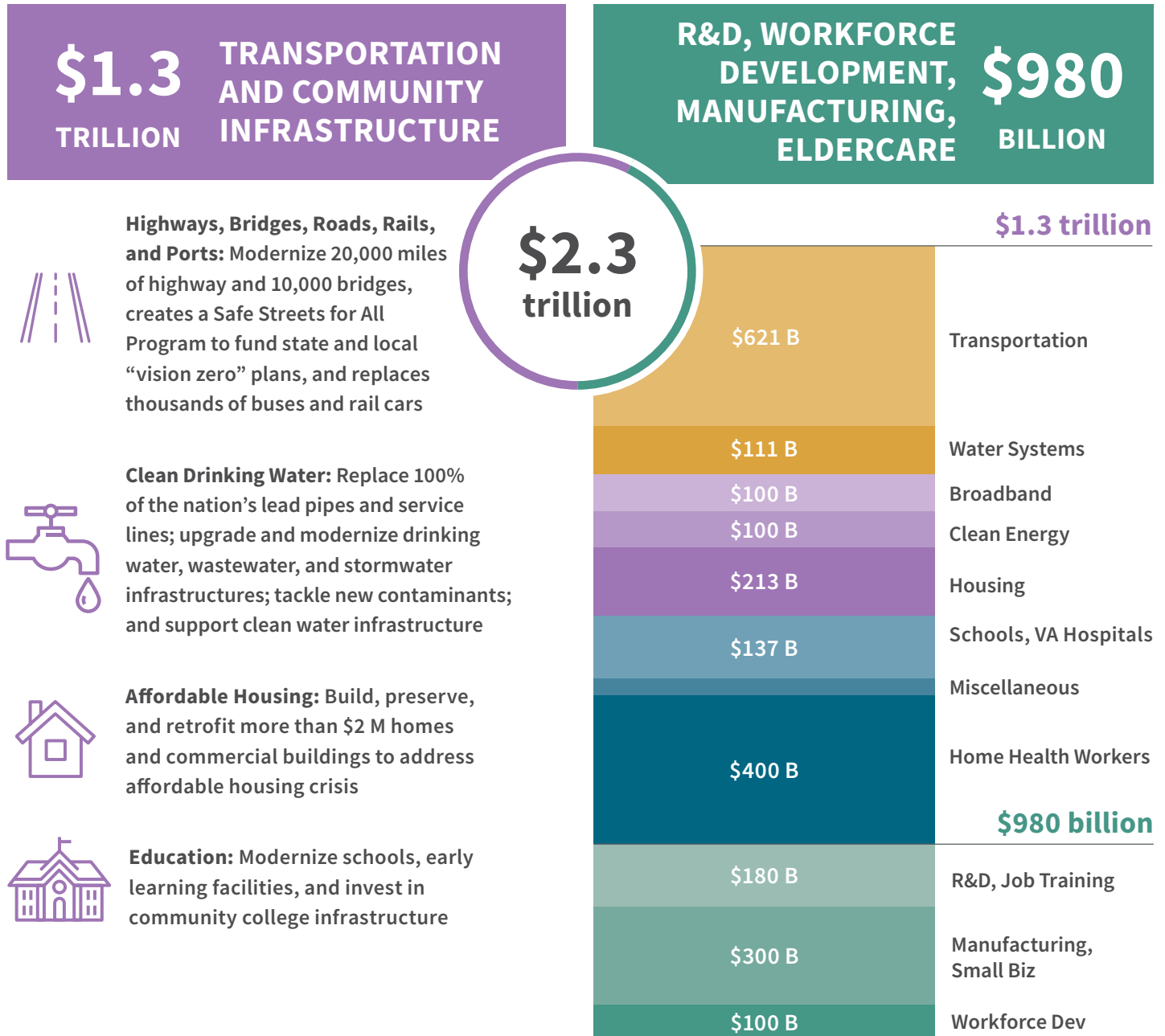


THE AMERICAN JOBS PLAN: WHAT CITIES AND COUNTIES NEED TO KNOW

The American Jobs Plan (AJP) proposes a nearly \$2.3 trillion dollar infrastructure and jobs investment over eight years, paid for with the “Made in America Tax Plan”, which outlines revenue sources intended to offset the investment levels made in AJP over the next 15 years. The proposed spending is broken down as follows:



THE PATH FORWARD

President Biden introduced AJP on March 31, 2021. The proposal is part of a two-pronged approach being taken by the White House, with the announcement of a second, “social infrastructure” package expected to follow later this month. Congress is now tasked with developing legislation around the President’s proposal that may eventually be enacted into law.
