


AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN: WHAT CITIES & COUNTIES NEED TO KNOW

The American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act of 2021 is a \$1.9 trillion economic stimulus bill. Within the ARP, the State and Local Coronavirus Fiscal Recovery Fund provides \$350 billion for states, municipalities, counties, tribes, and territories. The funding under this section is broken down as follows:
